The Town Lift from Main Street and Red Pine Gondola at the Canyons Village also unloads mountain bikers at access points for the IMBA Epic Ride on the Mid-Mountain Trail. Expert-Level Chainge Reaction Opens at Park City Mountain

Arriving mid-summer 2023, Park City Mountain will unveil their new expert-only downhill flow trail, Chainge Reaction. A collaboration between Mountain Trails Foundation and professional trail builder and Park City native Derek Thomson, the new trail will be accessible off Charlie's 9K just before the runout below Jupiter Peak. It will finish near the bottom of McConkey's lift and will include a return connector to Keystone. The steep drops, jumps, roots, rocks, and tight trees bring a more technical and feature-rich downhill option to Park City Mountain's current terrain offerings. Catalysts for Chainge Reaction are The Change Reaction Foundation Co-Founder Greg Perlman, and Vail Resorts, who donated their private land for public benefit.


Deer Valley Invests \$500,000+ in New Summer **Terrain**

In an effort to create more seamless connections between the resort's Snow Park base area and Silver Lake perched midmountain, Deer Valley will dedicate more than \$500,000 to new trails this season.

With the help of Gravity Logic, two new flow trails - the blue INTERMEDIATE TRAIL NAME and black EXPERT TRAIL NAME - will cascade down Bald Eagle this summer, along with a new dedicated hiking trail, HIKING TRAIL NAME. Ripple, the resort's newest green flow trail, will officially be open top to bottom this summer for a long, leisurely ride accessible to all levels. With so much new terrain to explore, Deer Valley will be offering twice the twilight with two nights of the ever-popular Twilight Ride Series of evening lift service on Tuesdays and Thursdays all summer long.




